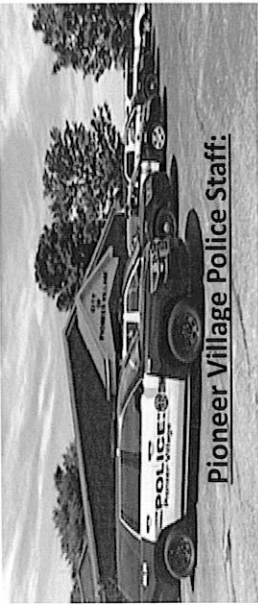

NO PARKING IS ALLOWED ON CITY STREETS

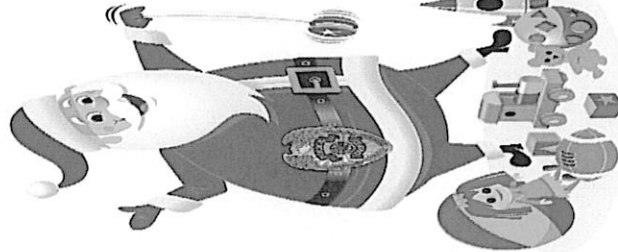

Dec. 31 & January 1st 10 pm-2am



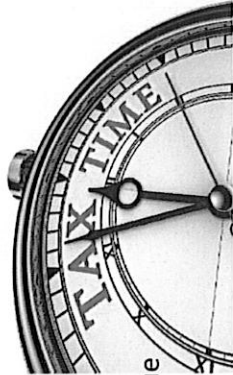
Pioneer Village Police 2021 SANTA'S HELPER PROGRAM

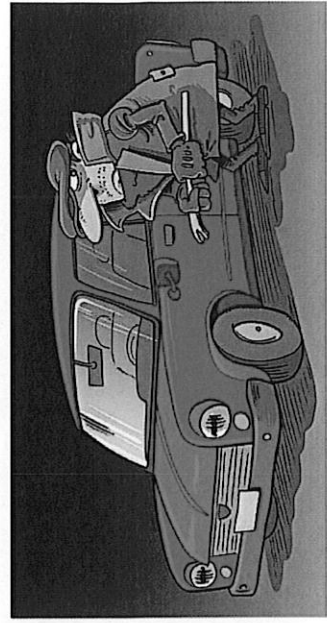


Chief's Corner
