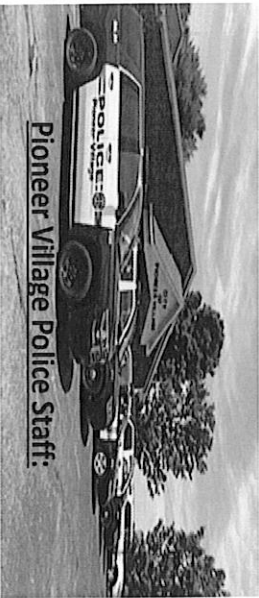

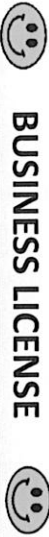

If you are having work done on your property, the Business must have a business license with the City. Please let your contractor know they must purchase a business license before the work begins. They can be fined if they do not have a business license.



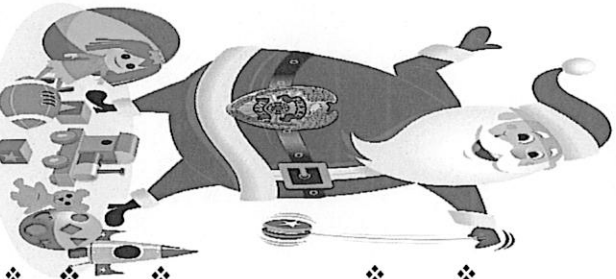

JULY 3, 4 & 5 9-11PM and Dec. 31 & January 1st 10 pm-2am

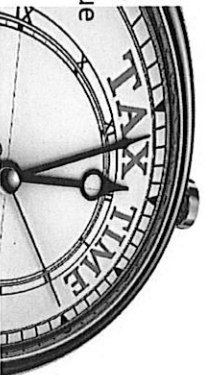
Pioneer Village Police 2022 SANTA'S HELPER PROGRAM



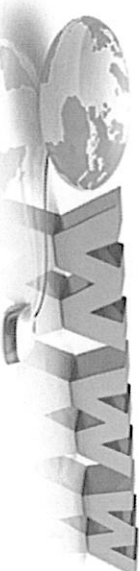
- ❖ Chief DJ Reynolds and the Santa's Helper Program need your help!

The City of Pioneer Village has contracted with The City Hillview to spray mosquitos 4 time a year. Remember if you have anything with standing water in it will draw mosquitos.

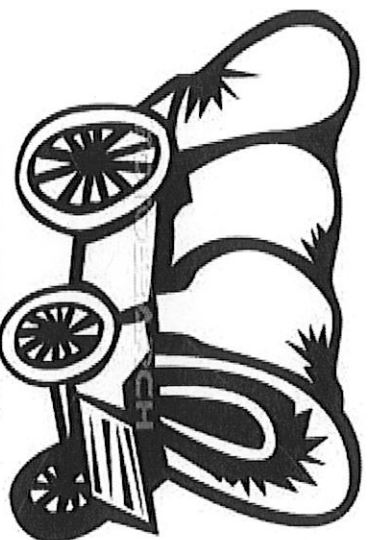
