

The new monthly rate is \$13.50 includes one mandatory WM cart and if needed additional carts for \$6.75 per month. Waste Management will be

for \$6.75 per month. Waste Management will be sending out cards with instructions and changes to the existing contract.

The commercial pricing for a 2yard dumpster 1x

week is \$121.00, 2x week is \$235.00.
Rolloff Service pricing for a 20yard open is \$195

per haul + Disposal \$35per ton + Monthly Fee \$90.
