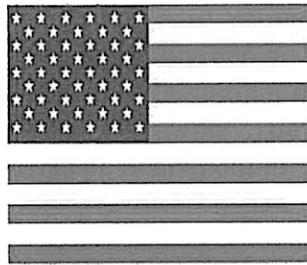
Trash pickup



We have a mandatory garbage ordinance, in the City of Pioneer Village, therefore, you must use Waste Management. The new contract will take effect July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028. The new monthly rate is \$13.50 includes one mandatory WM cart and if needed additional carts for \$6.75 per month. Waste Management will be sending out cards with instructions and changes to the existing contract. The commercial pricing for a 2yard dumpster 1x week is \$121.00, 2x week is \$235.00. Rolloff Service pricing for a 20yard open is \$195 per haul + Disposal \$35per ton + Monthly Fee \$90.

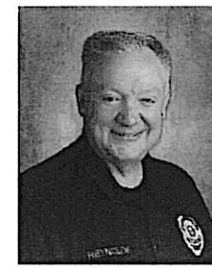
